



# 2016 IMPACTS: LINCOLN COUNTY



ICAN is a federally funded program of New Mexico State University whose mission is to inspire New Mexico's limited resource youth and adults to make healthy food and lifestyle choices.

In **Lincoln County**, ICAN employs one paraprofessional SNAP-Ed Nutrition Educator.

In FFY 16, Lincoln County SNAP-Ed reached a total of 456 adult participants and 713 youth participants.

A total of **713** youth were reached in schools across Lincoln County where ICAN provided fruit and vegetable tastings, nutrition education lessons, and healthy lifestyle tips.
